THE OVERVIEW

The Best of Ira is a short film about a young boy named Best and his father, Ira. Through five short acts, Best learns important lessons about life, love, and respect from his father. But tragedy strikes, leaving Best without both parents. Forced to move from his sheltered surroundings in the Chicago suburbs to a dangerous part of Chicago to live with his grandmother, Best begins to turn to a life of crime. However, a visit to his childhood home and memories of his father's teachings leads him to reexamine his actions, proving his father's most important lesson about the strength of the fatherson bond.

The Best of Ira is a short film based on the original screenplay, BEST (formerly, the Raising of an OG), that received recognition in 2022 from the Los Angeles International Screenplay Awards (semifinalist), Final Draft's Big Break (quarterfinalist), WeScreenplay's Diverse Voices (quarterfinalist), and the Filmmatic Drama Screenplay Awards (quarterfinalist).

The film is a poignant exploration of the bond between father and son and the harsh realities of life. It is a coming-of-age story that shows how a young boy learns to navigate the world around him with the help of his father's lessons.

The film is shot in a gritty, realistic style that captures the harsh realities of life in the inner city. The performances are raw and emotional, with the actors bringing a sense of authenticity to their roles. The film is a powerful exploration of the human experience and the ways in which we connect with one another in the face of adversity.

The film asks fathers to examine whether this approach is the best way to create emotionally intelligent and self-sufficient young men.
